<p>Water for irrigation</p> <p>Deposit of <u>silt</u> during floods</p> <p>Predictable planting season</p> <p>Development of calendar</p> <p>Food grown:</p> <p>Wheat → bread</p> <p>Lettuce, radishes, asparagus, cucumbers, dates, figs, watermelon, grapes</p>	<p><u>Riverbank mud</u></p> <p>Shelter (houses, walls)</p> <p>Bricks from the river mud mixed with dried marsh grass (similar to adobe)</p> <p>Pottery</p> <p>Statues</p> <p><u>Plants</u></p> <p>Papyrus → Paper</p> <p>Recordkeeping</p> <p>History</p> <p>Roofing material</p> <p>Mats</p> <p>Flax → Linen (clothing, mattresses, sheets, sails, mummifying material, bandages, curtains? towels? bags)</p> <p>Marsh grass → sandals, mats, roofs, nets, rope, fuel, stuffing, animal feed, baskets</p> <p>Reeds → boats, rafts</p> <p><u>Fish</u></p> <p>Crocodiles</p> <p><u>Animals</u> that come to river to drink (and can be hunted)</p> <p>Hippopotamus</p> <p>Birds that come to the river to drink (and can be hunted)</p> <p>Ibis, quail, ducks, geese</p> <p>Water for household uses:</p> <p>Drinking</p> <p>Washing themselves</p> <p>Washing clothes</p> <p>Washing dishes, etc.</p> <p>Boiling/cooking food</p>	<p>Down river (north) with current</p> <p>Up river (south) with wind and sails</p> <p>Trade</p> <p>Travel</p> <p>(Moving materials/people)</p> <p>Cataracts to prevent invasion from upriver</p> <p>Reeds for boats/rafts</p>
