Deadly Technology Weapons of the First World War

Using the reading titled, "First World War Weapons" complete the chart below with information about the weapons that were used during World War I to inflict huge numbers of casualties on both sides.

WEAPON	What was it?	How was it used against the other side?	How effective was this weapon?
Bolt-Action Rifle (with a bayonet)	a rifle that held multiple rounds with a dagger attached to the end of the barrel	good for trench warfare	15 rounds per minute & kill someone 1,400 meters away
Machine Gun	a gun that needed 4-6 men to carry it & must be positioned on a flat surface	good for trench warfare	400 rounds per minute had the fire power of 100 guns
Artillery	large calibre mounted field guns 12 men to work shells weighed up to 900lbs	in statesmates they delivered devastating blows over long distances	delivered devastating blows over long distances
Chlorine Gas	first used in 1915 by Germans at Ypres. smelled like a mixture of pepper & pineapple	looked like a smoke screen, did not realize they were being gased until they started having chest pains & burning sensation in throats	caused you to suffocate to death once you realized it was Chlorine it was too late
Mustard Gas	most deadly biological weapon used in trenches odorless gas & very powerful	small amounts were added to shells took 12 hours to take effect remained active in the ground for several weeks	made skin blister, eyes sore & vomiting, internal & external bleeding 5wks to die
Zeppelin	blimp also known as an airship	bombing raids against Germans carried machine guns & 4,400 lbs of bombs.	carried out many raids but were abandoned for artillery
Tank	"Little Willie" → armored vehicle "Tiat Tipo" →	→ carried a revolving turret	→ Not successful → more successful
Planes	flying machine bombs delivery	fighter planes had guns, bombs & cannons	"Dogfights" to protect ground troops reconnaissance work
